EU funding


- The EU is the largest provider of financial assistance to Kosovo
- The EU is supporting the socioeconomic development and reforms in the enlargement region, including in Kosovo, with financial and technical assistance through the **Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA)**
- For 2021-2027, IPA III funding for the whole enlargement region is **€14.162 billion**. It responds to thematic priorities
- The Annual Action Plan 2021 foresees a budget of **€63.96 million** supporting actions in the areas of governance (local government), demining, environment, economic development, agriculture & rural development
- For 2014 2020, IPA II funding allocated for Kosovo amounted to €573.1 million
- €300 million provided in European Investment Bank loans since 1999

The EU supports reforms in the enlargement region through the Instrument of Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA). Between 2021 -2027** the IPA III funding for the region is:

- Rule of Law, fundamental rights and democracy
 - Good governance and neighbourly relations Green agenda and

sustainable connectivity

- Competitiveness and inclusive growth
- Territorial and crossborder cooperation

- The EU pays special attention to youth, education and innovation

- 3,400+ participants from Kosovo in student, academic and youth exchanges under ERASMUS+
- 364 'Young Cells Scheme' grants have been awarded to public administration scholars
- 4,000+ young and disadvantaged people received employment and entrepreneurship training
- €18.5 million in support to civil society (2014-2020)
