Energy Efficiency

The EU's investment in energy efficiency has enabled Kosovo to reduce energy waste and improving energy efficiency.

in rehabilitating the district heating network in Pristina



€2.5 million

in Energy Community Treaty requirements through energy efficiency and renewables



€200 thousand

in technical assistance and investments through the Kosovo Energy Efficiency Fund (WBIF study)
